The Security Council

- 1 *Noting* the tentative acceptance of the nation of Pakistan to accepting refugees,
- 2 *Noting further* the pledging of humanitarian aid to Pakistan by several nations,
- 3 *Acknowledging* the humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan,
- 4 1. *Encourages* all member-states of the United Nations to accept women, children, injured, and
5 elderly refugees who are currently residing in Pakistan as the member-state is physically and
6 financially able;
- 7 2. *Recommends* that said refugees be repatriated immediately upon the achievement of stability in
8 Afghanistan;
- 9 3. *Urges* all states to contribute humanitarian aid to Pakistan to alleviate the current Afghani refugee
10 crisis and congratulates those who have contributed;
- 11 4. *Calls upon* the United Nations High Commission on Refugees (UNHCR) to improve all existing
12 refugee camps in Pakistan as necessary and create more if necessary and possible;
- 13 5. *Requests* the nation of Pakistan to only accept said refugees from Afghanistan and provide for their
14 well being;
- 15 6. *Requests* that any troops stationed between the borders of Afghanistan and Pakistan as well as the
16 UNHCR be on careful yet reasonable watch for any Taliban members and Al-Qaeda operatives
17 following the same framework that the United Nations Mission for Peace in Konduz was to abide
18 by as stipulated by Security Council resolution SC/2;
- 19 7. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
