The Security Council

- 1 Noting the tentative acceptance of the nation of Pakistan to accepting refugees,
- 2 Noting further the pledging of humanitarian aid to Pakistan by several nations,
- 3 Acknowledging the humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan,
- 1. *Encourages* all member-states of the United Nations to accept women, children, injured, and elderly refugees who are currently residing in Pakistan as the member-state is physically and financially able;
- 7 2. *Recommends* that said refugees be repatriated immediately upon the achievement of stability in Afghanistan;
- 9 3. *Urges* all states to contribute humanitarian aid to Pakistan to alleviate the current Afghani refugee crisis and congratulates those who have contributed;
- 4. *Calls upon* the United Nations High Commission on Refugees (UNHCR) to improve all existing refugee camps in Pakistan as necessary and create more if necessary and possible;
- 5. Requests the nation of Pakistan to only accept said refugees from Afghanistan and provide for their well being;
- Requests that any troops stationed between the borders of Afghanistan and Pakistan as well as the UNHCR be on careful yet reasonable watch for any Taliban members and Al-Qaeda operatives following the same framework that the United Nations Mission for Peace in Konduz was to abide by as stipulated by Security Council resolution SC/2;
- 19 7. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
