The following Presidential Statement was adopted by the Consensus of the Security Council:

Noting with deep regret the escalation of tensions between the sovereign nations of India and Pakististan, the Security Council wishes to make available the optimum conditions to have a debate to clear out all the differences between the two nations for the sake of world peace. The will of negotiation must exist and the international community urges both parties to exercise extreme caution. Remembering the Shimla Treaty, put into action on July 2, 1972 as a necessary tool to solves current differences to deter any military action, the Security Council is well aware of the ability of both parties to solve differences and to solve this conflict in a peaceful manner.
