

SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Rights of Refugees

The Commission on Human Rights

1 *Recognizing* the importance of the rights of refugees,

2 *Further recognizing* the 1951 UN convention on the status of refugees,

3 *Cognizant* of the importance of easing the burden of refugees on host states,

4 *Noting* that the best solution is one that does not solely ease the problem but also eliminates it
5 and prevents future occurrences,

- 6 1. *Urges* the international community to devote itself to furthering social and economic
7 security due to the plight of refugees;
- 8 2. *Further urges* the instatement of proactive measures by immediately dispatching a UN
9 investigation when a country expresses concern with a new refugee influx and the
10 committee should report to the UN body and immediate action should be taken to solve
11 the homeland situation;
- 12 3. *Further proclaims* that one of the highest priorities is recognizing and upholding the
13 unconditional right to return to a safe and secure homeland with the rights to land and
14 property;
- 15 4. *Further urges* the international community to back pre-established UNHCR programs in
16 providing funding to the homelands of the refugees to assist in reintegration;
- 17 5. *Strongly Recommends* and expects the United Nations to uphold and immediately enforce
18 previous resolutions such as Security Council's Resolution 242 (section 1- paragraph (1)
19 and section 2- paragraph (b) specifically) and UN Security Council Resolution 338 that
20 requires action for achieving a just settlement of the refugee problem in the Occupied
21 territories.

Final Vote: 20 in favor / 3 opposed / 7 abstentions.
