1	Realizing the need to address the i	issue of the increasing	number of refugees ar	ound the world,

- *Recognizing* that refugees pose a severe economic burden on hosting Member States, especially 2 3 developing nations,
- 4 Believing that the current distribution of funds is insufficient and unevenly allocated,
- Considering the different resource levels each Member State can contribute, and recognizing the 5 6 contributions already given to refugee aid,
- 7 *Reaffirming* the sovereignty of each Member State granted in the United Nations charter, Article 8 2.1,
- 9 *Calling on* the international community to aid each other in relieving this financial burden,
- Urges the United Nations Commission on Human Rights to create a new open-ended 10 1. working group in order to more efficiently review the collection and allocation of refugee 11 aid: 12
- 13 2. *Reaffirms* Paragraph 18 of Resolution 56/150 and Paragraph 19 of Resolution 2002/69 found in document E/CN.4/2002/116, and asks all Member States to cooperate with the 14 working group in order to set individual goals of resources to be contributed to refugee 15 aid; 16
- 17 3. *Encourages* private donors to contribute according to their willingness and ability;
- 18 4. Designates the working group to make an annual report to the UNCHR, with regards to resource allocation: 19

5. *Requests* that the UNCHR add the report to their agenda for the duration of the working group.
