The Second Committee

1 *Recognizing* that developed nations are reluctant to invest funds in countries whose industries are
2 lacking proper training,

3 *Taking into consideration* that education only grows with time,

4 *Desiring* the support of developed nations to invest in technology in lesser developed countries,

5 *Believing* that the benefits would eventually outweigh the risks after sufficient education of all
6 people,

7 *Recognizing* that the success of lesser developed countries does not only require funds, but also
8 education and training,

9 *Emphasizing* that this training will help integrate lesser developed and developing countries in
10 the multilateral trading system,

11 1. *Requests* from developed countries the sponsorship of less developed countries and
12 developing countries, to help them gain the necessary education and training;

13 2. *Requests* permission of developed member nations to host citizens of lesser developed
14 countries for educational training in industry, education, commerce, technology, science,
15 medicine, and other applicable fields;

16 3. *Requests* that members of this program be required to return to their home countries at
17 the end of the training period;

18 4. *Recommends* a partnership between countries to ensure the actual transfer of technology
19 from developed to developing and lesser developed countries, in order to facilitate the

5. *Affirms* that the investment value of education and technology transfer will only increase with time;

6. *Endorses* the expansion of already existing educational programs in the global community.\
