THE HISTORICAL SECURITY COUNCIL

- 1 Recalling its resolutions SC/Res/216 (November 12, 1965), SC/Res/217 (November 20, 1965), and SC/Res/221 (April 9, 1966) regarding the current situation in Southern Rhodesia,
- 3 Further recalling security resolution SC/Res/232 (December 16, 1966) which called for all
- nations to enforce economic sanctions that have been placed on Southern Rhodesia,
- 5 Concerned that some states are not doing their utmost to break their economic relations with the 6 minority regime in Southern Rhodesia and to enforce the economic sanctions in place as outlined 7 in resolution SC/Res/232,
- 8 1. *Condemns* South Africa and Portugal for violating UN imposed economic sanctions in Southern Rhodesia and actively trading with the illegal regime;
- 2. *Calls upon* member states to continue to diligently enforce current economic sanctions concerning Southern Rhodesia as outlined in resolution SC/Res/232.
- 12 3. Respectfully Recommends that the Economic and Social Council consider the
 13 establishment of a commission under their auspices to evaluate the effect of sanctions on
 14 third party states.
