SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Implementation of the Outcome of the World Summit For Social Development and of the Twenty-Fourth Special Session of the General Assembly

The General Assembly

1 *Noting with appreciation* the Copenhagen Declaration ten commitments in a variety of issues
2 relating to social development,

3 *Noting with deep concern* the worldwide conditions that pose severe threats to the health of the
4 world community such as inadequate healthcare; malnutrition; illicit drug problems; gender oppression;
5 organized crime; and corruption,

6 *Recalling* A/55/344, 1 Sep 2000, Twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly,

7 *Affirming* the goals and objectives of social development require continuous efforts to reduce
8 and eliminate major sources of social distress and instability for the family and for society,

9 *Recognizing* that each member state has unique social development assistance,

10 1. *Invites* more member states to move toward the agreed target donation of 0.7% of GNP
11 for official development assistance;

12 2. *Congratulates* member states resolve toward coordination and cooperation at the
13 national level and especially at regional and international levels;

14 3. *Resolves* to incrementally increase towards 0.7% of GNP based on developing nations
15 success;

16 4. *Affirms* that the UNDP will work toward providing some level of aid to all least developed
17 nations while maintaining flexibility in allocation of funds in order to give extra
18 consideration to urgent needs;

- 20 5. *Suggests* that the UNDP works in accordance with the government of each recipient state
21 to create a timeline for the achievement of set goals;
- 22 6. *Has resolved* that the states receiving the funds will report to the commission every two
23 years to reevaluate the social development;
- 24 7. *Designates* that Third Committee of the General Assembly to evaluate the progress of the
25 UNDP and the individual Member States through biannual progress reports;
- 26 8. *Further requests* that twenty percent of member-state contributions go to the general
27 funds and eighty percent to social development issues that each member-state sees fit.
