11 12 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 22 April 1961, in connection with the Council s consideration of the item entitled The Situation in Tunisia, the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council.

The Security Council welcomes the positive outcome regarding the situation in Tunisia. In light of the complaint brought by Tunisia to the Council in regard to heightened tensions and the question of dispute over the sovereignty of France's military base, we congratulate both France and Tunisia for their rapid and amicable resolution of the dispute.

The Council expresses its sadness for the unfortunate losses suffered by both parties to the dispute, but highly praises both parties for their openness to discussion and applauds the achievement of the immediate cease-fire. Much gratitude is in order for the United States instrumental mediation provided to France and Tunisia. Their willingness to provide a neutral perspective serves as a fine example of diplomacy and actuating compromise.
