Recalling the mandate for the UN Mission in Liberia established in resolution 1509, Understanding the constraints facing UNMIL due to the lack of requested troops, Emphasizing the influence of drugs upon the situation in Liberia, Deploring the repeated violations of human rights, 1. Urges UN member states to contribute additional peacekeeping troops in order to fulfill the authorized strength of UNMIL; 2. Decides that the mandate for UNMIL will be expanded to include; (a) to make every effort to establish security checkpoints across the Liberia's border in order to minimize the flow of arms and drugs into the country; (b) to actively seek out and eliminate all sources and venues of drugs within Liberia; (c) to continue to carry out the complete disarmament of all forces recognized by UNMIL to be actively engaged in conflict; 3. Strongly recommends the ratification of the Optional Protocol on the Involvement of Children in Armed Conflict by UN member states;

4. Recommends the UNMIL, in fulfillment of its mandate in resolution 1509, pay

particular attention to the psychological needs of formal child soldiers;
