SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Elimination of Racism and Racial Discrimination

SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly

1           *The General Assembly*

2  
3           *Recalling* the relevance of the 1969 International Convention on the Elimination of All  
4 Forms of Racial Discrimination's definition on racism,

5  
6           *Reaffirming* the rights of each nation to sovereignty within its own borders,

7  
8           *Promoting* extensive diplomatic efforts before any nation infringes upon another's  
9 sovereign rights unless an international consensus is reached,

10  
11           *Recognizing* the distinction that exists between politically and ethnically-driven  
12 government actions within a country,

13  
14           *Alarmed* by the recent resurgence of international Islamophobia,

15  
16           1. *Calls upon* economically developed nations and to aid NGOs in the implementation of  
17 race education programs in developing and post-colonial nations;

18  
19           (a) Emphasizes the need for developed countries and to NGOs financially contribute to the  
20 development strategies of developing/post-colonial nations so that educational programs can be  
21 maintained in the future;

23           (b) Calls upon the CERD (Committee on the Elimination Racial Discrimination) to create  
24 these educational programs based upon regional needs, and implement them on a regional basis;

25  
26           (c) *Also calls upon* an ad-hoc committee to assess CERD's progress within the timeframe  
27 of one year, to be followed by a reassessment a year from that point;

28  
29           2. *Discourages* any effort to forcibly separate racial groups based on Islamophobia.

Final Vote:66 in favor /14 opposed / 25 abstentions
