SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Elimination of Racism and Racial Discrimination

SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly

The General Assembly

 *Recalling* the relevance of the 1969 International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination's definition on racism,

Reaffirming the rights of each nation to sovereignty within its own borders,

*Promoting* extensive diplomatic efforts before any nation infringes upon another's sovereign rights unless an international consensus is reached,

*Recognizing* the distinction that exists between politically and ethnically-driven government actions within a country,

Alarmed by the recent resurgence of international Islamophobia,

- 1. *Calls upon* economically developed nations and to aid NGOs in the implementation of race education programs in developing and post-colonial nations;
- (a) Emphasizes the need for developed countries and to NGOs financially contribute to the development strategies of developing/post-colonial nations so that educational programs can be maintained in the future;
- (b) Calls upon the CERD (Committee on the Elimination Racial Discrimination) to create these educational programs based upon regional needs, and implement them on a regional basis;
- (c) *Also calls upon* an ad-hoc committee to assess CERD's progress within the timeframe of one year, to be followed by a reassessment a year from that point;
  - 2. Discourages any effort to forcibly separate racial groups based on Islamophobia.

Final Vote:66 in favor /14 opposed / 25 abstentions
