

SUBMITTED TO: International Atomic Energy Agency	
The International Atomic Energy Agency,	
Recognizing the importance of the IAEA safeguarding process in furthering and ensuring the process of global nuclear non-proliferation,	5
Noting with satisfaction the extensive amount of information the IAEA has obtained in over 900 nuclear facilities throughout the world,	
Fully aware that the IAEA uses a computer system to track information on these facilities	es.
Realizing the current operating system was built in the late 1970s,	
Disturbed by the lack of updated technology in this essential agency,	
Deeply concerned that the current operating system is both out of date and structurally unable to cope with both the widespread creation of new nuclear plants and massive amounts of updated nuclear information,	•
1. <i>Requests</i> the creation of an international taskforce of computer specialists charged with improving the IAEA safeguard computer system;	
2. Recommends a complete upgrade of the IAEA computer system;	
3. <i>Solemnly affirms</i> a continued support of the IAEA and its safeguarding / verification procedures.	
Final Vote: 20 in favor / 6 opposed / 4 abstentions
