1 *International Atomic Energy Agency,*

3 *Welcoming* the developing world's interest in nuclear power,

4
5 *Deeply convinced* it will speed up development of the developing world and provide it
6 with a cheap and clean energy source that will provide more than enough energy to sustain it into
7 the foreseeable future,

8
9 1. Calls upon the developed world to assist in this development and ensure that it
10 continues in a way that is beneficial to the international community;

11
12 2. *Urges* openness in atomic research in order to provide the latest techniques in
13 nuclear waste disposal to the developing world;

15 3. *Further Recommends* that a group of IAEA physicists be made available to any
16 country interested in developing peaceful nuclear capabilities in order to ensure the
17 developing world is able to handle the responsibility and ramifications of nuclear
18 materials;

20 4. *Considers* that the increased use of nuclear material will need additional
21 oversight and cooperation throughout the world;

23 5. *Declares* Accordingly that, through the cooperation of developed countries
24 and underdeveloped countries, the infusion of nuclear energy into the
25 underdeveloped world should go much smoother than if just left to their own devices.

Final Vote: 14 in favor / 3 opposed / 12 abstentions
