SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION:	Safety of Research Reactors

International Atomic Energy Agency,

Welcoming the developing world's interest in nuclear power,

Deeply convinced it will speed up development of the developing world and provide it with a cheap and clean energy source that will provide more than enough energy to sustain it into the foreseeable future,

- 1. Calls upon the developed world to assist in this development and ensure that it continues in a way that is beneficial to the international community;
- 2. *Urges* openness in atomic research in order to provide the latest techniques in nuclear waste disposal to the developing world;
- 3. Further Recommends that a group of IAEA physicists be made available to any country interested in developing peaceful nuclear capabilities in order to ensure the developing world is able to handle the responsibility and ramifications of nuclear materials:
- 4. *Considers* that the increased use of nuclear material will need additional oversight and cooperation throughout the world;
- 5. *Declares* Accordingly that, through the cooperation of developed countries and underdeveloped countries, the infusion of nuclear energy into the underdeveloped world should go much smoother than if just left to their own devices.
