SUBJECT OF THE RESOLUTION: The Situation in Sudan
SUBMITTED TO:The Security Council
SUBMITTED BY:Chile, Pakistan, China, United Kingdom, Benin, Germany, Russian Federation
The Security Council
Guided by the principles put forth within the Charter of the United Nation,
Recalling operative clause 4 put forth in resolution SC 2,
Deeply disturbed by the continuing and heightening tension in the Darfur region of Sudan,
<i>Having considered</i> all courses of action available to resolve the problems pertaining the Sudanese conflict,
1. <i>Deplores</i> the actions taken by the Sudanese government that have resulted in the prevention of humanitarian aide distribution;
2. <i>Urges</i> the immediate resolution of the extreme congestion generated by the vehicle inspection procedures implemented at all border checkpoints;
3. Strongly Urges the redistribution of Sudanese forces back to the Darfur region;
4. Recommends rapid distribution of food, fuel, and especially water;
5. <i>Accepts</i> requests made by the African Union as validation for deployment of assistance in guaranteeing the distribution of humanitarian aide as outlined in resolution SC 2 and this resolution;
6. <i>Designates</i> personnel pledges only as unarmed observers with the purpose of guaranteeing the delivery of humanitarian aide and are there only to secure the welfare of the humanitarian envoy and work in coordination with the African Union forces currently deployed to Sudan;
7. <i>Confirms</i> all UN and African Union personnel will maintain constant communication with the Secretary General of the UN;
8. Decides to remain seized in this matter.
Final Vote: 11 in favor / 0 opposed / 2 abstentions
