Recalling Article 25 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, "everyone has the right to a standard of living, adequate health and well-being, including food..." International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights,

Acknowledging the importance of equality of rights between men and women in terms of access and ownership to land, as stated in Article 17 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,

Deeply concerned with the disadvantages that women and children face in underdeveloped and developing nations in accessing nutritious food, as expressed in A/Res/59/202, "that women are disproportionately affected by hunger, food insecurity and poverty, in part as a result of gender inequality...,"

 $Fully\ alarmed$ with the lack of training and education opportunities to contribute to the food production,

- 1. *Strongly promotes* the full realization of the International Human Rights Covenant and other conventions;
- 2. Further invites states to support the World Solidarity Fund in order to put into operation mechanisms designed to provide training and education opportunities for women;
- 3. *Recommends* that the Second Committee of the General Assembly takes into consideration additional support for micro credit and micro finance loans particularly addressed to women in underdeveloped and developing nations as means to generate financial stability;
- 4. *Calls upon* nation states to acknowledge the crucial role of women in food productions by providing women in underdeveloped and developing nations with unlimited access to agricultural production resources, training, education, technical information, and services.
