



SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Panama Canal Zone  
SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council  
SUBMITTED BY: Australia, China, Kenya, Panama, Peru, Yugoslavia

*The Historical Security Council*

1 *Affirming* the principles of the United Nations with regard to the situation  
2 involving the United States of America and the Panama Canal Zone,  
3

4 *Stressing* the importance of Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 1 of the United Nations  
5 Charter, which states, “The organization is based on the principle of the sovereign  
6 equality of all its Members,”  
7

8 *Concerned* about the neutrality of the Panama Canal,  
9

10 *Noting* that the economic benefits of the Panama Canal should more directly  
11 benefit the nation of Panama,  
12

13 *Fully Aware* that defense of the Canal would still require the aid of Panama's  
14 traditional allies,  
15

16 1. *Congratulates* the United States of America on their dedication to spreading the  
17 United Nations mission of sovereignty;  
18

19 2. *Calls Upon* the United States of America and Panama to cooperate in treaty  
20 negotiations regarding the Panama Canal and the Panama Canal Zone;  
21

22 3. *Determines* that a treaty negotiating the sovereignty of the Panama Canal is  
23 necessary, and affirms that the discussions concerning the treaty will take place;

25 4. *Acknowledges* the United States of America as a valuable ally to Panama;

27 5. *Requests* that Panama obtains increased cooperation in the control and defense  
28 of the Panama Canal;

30 6. *Emphasizes* the immediate need for enhancement of economic benefits to  
31 Panama;

33           7. *Further invites* all member states to support the negotiation process regarding  
34 the Panama Canal Zone;

36           8. *Reaffirms* the need for the sovereignty and independence of nations throughout  
37 the world, in conjunction with international political and economic independence.
