1 2 3	Affirming the principles of the United Nations with regard to the situation involving the United States of America and the Panama Canal Zone,
4 5 6	<i>Stressing</i> the importance of Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 1 of the United Nations Charter, which states, "The organization is based on the principle of the sovereign equality of all its Members,"
7 8 9	Concerned about the neutrality of the Panama Canal,
10 11	<i>Noting</i> that the economic benefits of the Panama Canal should more directly benefit the nation of Panama,
12 13 14	<i>Fully Aware</i> that defense of the Canal would still require the aid of Panama's traditional allies,
15 16 17	1. <i>Congratulates</i> the United States of America on their dedication to spreading the United Nations mission of sovereignty;
18 19 20	2. <i>Calls Upon</i> the United States of America and Panama to cooperate in treaty negotiations regarding the Panana Canal and the Panama Canal Zone;
21 22 23	3. <i>Determines</i> that a treaty negotiating the sovereignty of the Panama Canal is necessary, and affirms that the discussions concerning the treaty will take place;
24 25 26	4. Acknowledges the United States of America as a valuable ally to Panama;
27 28 29	5. <i>Requests</i> that Panama obtains increased cooperation in the control and defense of the Panama Canal;
29 30 31 32	6. <i>Emphasizes</i> the immediate need for enhancement of economic benefits to Panama;

- *7. Further invites* all member states to support the negotiation process regarding
 the Panama Canal Zone;

- 8. *Reaffirms* the need for the sovereignty and independence of nations throughout
 the world, in conjunction with international political and economic independence.
