*The Security Council*

1           *Recognizing* its primary responsibility under Article 24 of the Charter to maintain  
2 international peace and security,

3  
4           *Acknowledging* Resolution 49/59, the High-Level Panel on Threats, Challenges,  
5 and Change and the Secretary General's report to the General Assembly: In Larger  
6 Freedom,

7  
8           *Recognizing* that as times change, the nature of peacekeeping must also adapt,  
9

10           *Noting with deep concern* the recent situations that have hindered the  
11 effectiveness of UN peacekeeping missions, such as those missions in the Congo,  
12 Ethiopia, Eritrea, and Cote d'Ivoire,

13  
14           *Desiring* that peacekeeping missions of the United Nations continue to operate  
15 successfully and effectively,

16  
17           *Acting* under Article 29 of the Charter,

18  
19           1. *Authorizes* for a committee to be formed at the discretion of the Secretary  
20 General in conjunction with the Security Council to make recommendations concerning  
21 general peacekeeping issues;

23           2. *Places* particular emphasis on the following issues:

24  
25                   (a) Protocols over the safety of peacekeepers,

26  
27                   (b) Protocols concerning the conduct of peacekeepers,

28  
29                   (c) Responses to contravention of those protocols,

30

31 (d) Feasibility of impementing those protocols in current and future  
32 peacekeeping missions;  
33  
34 3. *Calls* for the committee to submit a report to the Security Council within six  
35 months after its formation.

Passed by consensus, with 1 abstentions
