1 2 3	Acknowledging the progress made in curbing the trade of illicit arms, particularly in Somalia via Resolution 1630 (2005),
4 5 6	<i>Recalling</i> paragraph 7 of Resolution 1572 (2004) which establishes the ability of the United Nations to moniter the trade of illicit weapons in Cote d' Ivoir,
0 7 8 9	<i>Further recognizing</i> Resolution 1584 (2005) establishing a Group of Experts to oversee the monitoring ability of the United Nations,
9 10 11 12	<i>Emphasizing</i> the report from the Group of Experts which called for an evaluation of weapons importation in Cote d' Ivoire,
13 14 15	<i>Noting</i> with deep concern the growth in illicit arms trading in the region despite the efforts of the United Nations in Cote d' Ivoire (UNOCI), Liberia (UNMIL), and Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL),
16 17 18 19	<i>Concerned</i> that the influx of arms to Cote d' Ivoire is making peace impossible by worsening the conflict between the rebels and the government,
20 21	Noting that the cocoa and diamond trade aided in the purchase of these weapons,
21 22 23	Alarmed by the recent increase in violence and deaths within the nation,
24 25	1. <i>Calls upon</i> the Security Council to develop a Monitoring Group to further the goals of the Group of Experts in:
26 27 28	(a) Collecting information on individuals and groups that violate the arms embargo in Cote d'Ivoire,
29 30 31 32	(b) Investigating into the relationship between the illicit arms trade and its links to both the cocoa trade and diamond trade,

(c) Aiding the investigative efforts of both the UN Operation in Cote
d'Ivoire and the Kimberly Process Certification Scheme;
2. *Requests* the Monitoring Group report its findings to the Security Council
within six months;

39 3. *Emphasizes* the ability of this monitoring group to better facilitate the arms
 40 embargo in Cote d'Ivoire.
