The First Committee

1 *Deeply disturbed* by the potential threat of terrorists acquiring nuclear weapons,

2

3 *Acknowledging* the necessity of the trade of nuclear materials and technology
4 solely for the purposes of energy,

5

6 *Noting with approval* the rising use of nuclear technology for the purpose of
7 energy in developing countries,

8

9 *Deeply concerned* by the lack of transparency in the trade of nuclear materials,

10

11 *1. Strongly condemns* the use of nuclear weapons technology for terrorist acts;

13 *2. Reminds* member states that the possibility of nuclear terrorism threatens the
14 safety of all nations;

16 *3. Endorses* the use and development of nuclear technology exclusively for the
17 purposes of energy;

19 *4. Recommends* that countries take measures to increase transparency of the trade
20 of nuclear materials;

22 *5. Calls upon* the international community to establish regulations for trade of
23 factors of production of nuclear technology.
