9 10 11 12	Recalling Resolution 626 passed on December 20th, 1988, and 628 passed on January 16th, 1989, addressing the withdrawal of Cuban soldiers from Angola,	
12 13 14 15 16	1. <i>Calls</i> for the immediate commencement of talks to be held in Paris between Cuba, South Africa, UNITA, and MPLA for the purpose of resolving the ongoing situation;	
17 18 19	2. <i>Urges</i> all armed factions to suspend hostile activities and allow diplomatic efforts a chance to resolve the dispute through peaceful means;	
20 21 22	3. <i>Requests</i> Cuba to continue the phased withdrawal of troops from Angola in accordance with the timetable established in the Angola-Namibian accords;	
23 24 25	4. <i>Calls upon</i> , all factions involved in the situation in Angola to implement Resolution 628;	
26 27 28 29	5. Authorizes the expansion of UNAVEM to the capacity of 600 soldiers to be supplied by Canada, Colombia and Malaysia, in order to facilitate the withdrawal of Cuban forces and monitor the security situation in Angola.
