SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Southern Africa  
SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council  
SUBMITTED BY: Cuba, Ethiopia, Malaysia, Russian Federation, Zaire

*The Historical Security Council,*

1 *Concerned* with continued instances of violence in Angola, and the instability and  
2 challenges to regional security presented by the situation,  
3

4 *Aware* that recent actions have derailed the path to peace,  
5

6 *Believing* the Angolan-Namibian accords to be incomplete to properly ensure  
7 lasting stability in Angola,  
8

9 *Recalling* Resolution 626 passed on December 20th, 1988, and 628 passed on  
10 January 16th, 1989, addressing the withdrawal of Cuban soldiers from Angola,  
11

13 1. *Calls* for the immediate commencement of talks to be held in Paris between  
14 Cuba, South Africa, UNITA, and MPLA for the purpose of resolving the ongoing  
15 situation;  
16

17 2. *Urges* all armed factions to suspend hostile activities and allow diplomatic  
18 efforts a chance to resolve the dispute through peaceful means;  
19

20 3. *Requests* Cuba to continue the phased withdrawal of troops from Angola in  
21 accordance with the timetable established in the Angola-Namibian accords;  
22

23 4. *Calls upon*, all factions involved in the situation in Angola to implement  
24 Resolution 628;  
25

26 5. *Authorizes* the expansion of UNAVEM to the capacity of 600 soldiers to be  
27 supplied by Canada, Colombia and Malaysia, in order to facilitate the withdrawal of  
28 Cuban forces and monitor the security situation in Angola.
