SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Angola

The Historical Security Council

1 *Gravely Concerned* with the continued violence in Angola and the abduction of
2 United Nations personnel in the region,
3

4 *Deeply Distressed* by the disregard for international statutes and practices
5 demonstrated by UNITA,
6

7 *Saddened* by the needless loss of life of individuals dedicated to the establishment
8 of international security,
9

10 *Aware* that such actions are contrary to the desire for the establishment of a
11 peaceful situation in Angola,
12

13 1. *Strongly Condemns* the attacks by UNITA on United Nations personnel;
14

15 2. *Demands* that UNITA acts in accordance with accepted international practices
16 regarding the humane treatment of captives in times of conflict;
17

18 3. Further *Demands* the immediate and unconditional release of United Nations
19 personnel by UNITA forces by a date no later than 7/21/1990

21 4. *Requests* regional and global actors previously or currently associated with
22 UNITA to actively work towards the release of United Nations personnel;

24 5. *Calls Upon* UNITA to comply with HSC 6 and immediately participate in four
25 party talks as mediated by the United Nations;

27 6. *Decides* as a consequence of this action, that Member States shall immediately
28 halt all sale and supply of UNITA, including weapons and other military equipment,
29 excepting medical supplies and foodstuffs;

31 7. *Decides* to remain actively seized on this topic
