1 *Recognizing* the critical role education plays in sustainable human development,
2 providing the means to overcome poverty, social inequality, and to put to an end
3 continuous cycles of conflict,
4

5 *Reaffirming* the Dakar Framework for Action, which established goals
6 recognizing that education is they key to developing peace and stability within and among
7 countries,
8

9 *Emphasizing* the need for regions undergoing times of trauma and upset to have
10 the means to quickly restore educational services, and the international community's duty
11 to assist in providing these means,
12

13 *Noting* that education is a critical investment in promoting global stability,
14

15 *Noting with concern* that when providing financial assistance to meet other
16 legitimate emergency needs of regions, critical funding for education often gets lost,
17

18 1. *Calls for* the formation of a regional partnership to be called Regional
19 Emergency Education Partnership (REEP), an agreement of nations of similar
20 geographical and ideological framing:
21

22 (a) this partnership will be of a voluntary nature;
23

24 (b) this partnership will be used for regions who have experienced trauma due to
25 natural disasters;

27 2. *Declares* that the partnership will provide services to include sending critical
28 educational inputs such as, but not limited to, teachers, school supplies, and supplies for
29 rebuilding and re-establishing educational infrastructure;

3. *Establishes* that nations in need will release a report listing the critical educational resources of which they are in need;

4. *Declares* that at the will of the member nations, UNESCO may facilitate guidance over the transactions determined voluntarily by the member nations themselves;

5. *Establishes* that any nation may withdraw from a REEP at any time for any purpose and receive no ramifications;

6. *Encourages* REEPs to lend support to other REEPs in which that entire region has been effected by a natural disaster.
