- 1 *Bearing* in mind the current large number of refugees and displaced persons
2 globally,

- 4 *Fully aware* that issues relating to refugees and displaced persons effect every
5 corner of the globe,

- 7 *Recognizing* that since 1945 world conflicts have produced 20 million refugees
8 and 30 million displaced persons,
9
- 10 *Recognizing* that at least sixty percent of these refugees and displaced persons are
11 children,
12
- 13 *Reaffirms* the provisions of the Dakar Framework for Action,
14
- 15 *Recognizing* that the Millennium Development Goals stress education for all,
- 17 *Observing* that a large number of refugees and displaced persons reside within
18 refugee camps and often lack adequate educational structure,

- 20 1. *Encourages* the increased mobility of the educational structure to better serve
21 refugees and displaced persons;

- 23 2. *Urges* the body to increase funding for mobile educational structures with
24 regards to refugees and displaced persons;

- 26 3. *Encourages* primary assistance to come from regional countries if they are
27 capable of providing such assistance;

29 4. *Encourages* increased coordination between the United Nations, Literacy
30 Education Training Sites (LETS), and all international bodies in implementing mobile
31 educational structure to support the educational needs of refugees and displaced persons.
