1 *Fully alarmed* by the state of both civil and international strife in developing
2 nations,

3
4 *Deeply disturbed* by violent crimes against civilians,

5
6 *Noting with regret* the difficulties faced by civilians in accessing educational
7 facilities due to violent attacks and threats of danger,

8
9 *Fully believing* the vital importance of global education,

10
11 *Convinced* that the availability of education is key in reducing disparities in and
12 maintaining gender equality,

13
14 *Emphasizing* that education produces states that are more able to compete in an
15 economically globalized world,

16
17 *Seeking* the assistance of non-governmental organizations and bodies of the
18 United Nations,

19
20 1. *Calls upon* the bodies of the United Nations to provide basic means of
21 transportation for students to educational facilities;

22
23 2. *Designates* that eligibility be based upon request by the state, given that the
24 state be experiencing a situation(s) of emergency and crisis, as defined by the United
25 Nations.

27 3. *Endorses* that such transportation be suitable to the geographic nature of
28 affected states;

29
30 4. *Recommends* that such means of transportation be operated by peaceful non-

31 governmental organizations;

33 5. *Has resolved* that such means of transportation will not be implemented for the
34 uses of commercial, governmental, or any non-educational purposes;

36 6. *Recommends* that the United Nations shall be responsible for maintaining the
37 operation of said means of transportation.
