1 2 3 4	<i>Recalling</i> numerous resolutions calling for the establishment of nuclear weapon- free zones including, but not limited to, General Assembly Resolutions A/Res/61/65, A/Res/61/69, A/Res/61/92,
4 5	Regretting certain States' lack of compliance with the Nuclear Non-Proliferation
6	Treaty (NPT) despite the continued efforts of the General Assembly,
7	
8	Understanding the fact that greater transparency among States greatly reduces the
9	risk of non-state actors acquiring these materials,
10	
11	<i>Recognizing</i> the threat of nuclear weapons on the global community,
12	
13	<i>Recalling</i> the failure of sincere diplomatic attempts towards nuclear disarmament,
14 15	leaving the international community to take a new direction,
16	1. Calls Upon all States not party to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of
17	Nuclear Weapons (NPT) to sign and ratify without delay, and follow all provisions
18	therein;

20	2. Urges the strengthening of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA)
21	monitoring system, through the full adoption and implementation of Comprehensive
22	Safeguards and Additional Protocols, including powers such as:
23	(a) IAEA inspector access to, all parts of a state's nuclear fuel cycle
24	(including uranium mines, fuel fabrication enrichment plants, and
25	nuclear waste sites) as well as to any other locations where nuclear
26	material is or may be present;
27	(b) IAEA short notice access to all buildings on a nuclear site;
28 29	(c) IAEA collection of environmental samples at locations beyond
27	declared locations when deemed necessary by the IAEA;

30	(d) IAEA right to make use of internationally established communication
31	systems, including systems and other forms of telecommunication;
32	(e) State acceptance of IAEA inspector designations and issuance of
33	multiple entry visas (valid for at least one year) for inspectors;
34	
35	3. Declares the need for total disarmament in accordance with Article VI of the
36	NPT in the global community, thus preventing the utilization, creation, and transportation
37	of nuclear weapons;
38	
39	4. <i>Calls upon</i> all nations to adhere to the utilization, transportation of nuclear
40	weapons excluding territorial waters.
