<i>Understanding</i> the need to address peacekeeping reforms in a comprehensive manner,	
Recognizing the many challenges facing peacekeeping operations today,	
1. <i>Encourages</i> the United Nations to partner with regional organizations in order to coordinate missions and improve standards of training and equipment;	
2. <i>Strongly suggests</i> reforms that will increase the accountability of peacekeepers in order to protect civilian populations;	

3. *Calls for* all peacekeeping missions to have a clear mandate, unambiguous rules of engagement, and objective-based withdrawal strategies;

- 4. Suggests that reforms be implemented to increase the speed and efficiency with which peacekeeping units may be deployed;
- 5. *Recommends* that all vested parties are integrated into the decision making process.
