The Fourth Committee,

2 *Recalling* its resolution 2006 (XIX) of 18 February, 1965 creating the Special
3 Committee on Peace-Keeping Operations (SCPO) and other relevant resolutions,

4
5 *Further recalling* the Secretary General's report A/61/668 of 13 February, 2007
6 updating the SCPO on the current relevant issues and challenges in peacekeeping,

7
8 *Welcoming* with appreciation the continued progress made in implementing the
9 reforms contained within the Brahimi report (A/55/305)

10
11 *Stressing* the importance of maintaining national sovereignty and the democratic
12 coordination of all peacekeeping operations between host nations and contributors,

13
14 *Recognizing* that inter-governmental regional organizations, regional and local
15 non-governmental organizations and regional and local transnational organizations with
16 the capacity for divestment have an invested interest in the resolution of conflict and
17 long-term stability in their respective regions,

18
19 *Optimistic* about the recent partnering with the United Nations and the African
20 Union in its first hybrid operation UNMIS (United Nations Mission in the Sudan),

21
22 *Fully aware* that transparency is consistent with the prevailing requirements for
23 security parties who should have a clear understanding of the motives, mission and
24 intentions of the operation,

25
26 1. *Calls* upon the United Nations to form partnerships between peacekeeping
27 forces and internationally recognized regional authorities in order to promote
28 understanding and culturally-sensitive missions,

29 2. *Further requests* that the Security Council strengthens collaboration between

30 the Department of Peacekeeping Operations and host governments, both in the planning
31 and implementation processes of UN-mandated peacekeeping missions,

32 3. *Urges* the addition of all host governments to the Special Committee on
33 Peacekeeping Operations in order to ensure continued participation by host governments
34 through the duration of all missions emphasizing respect for host nation's sovereignty,

35 4. *Calls* for a comprehensive integration of all vested parties in areas of conflict
36 into the Special Committee on Peacekeeping Operations and/or the Specialized
37 Committees dealing with each individual mandated mission in an advisory capacity, to
38 include:

39 (a) Inter-governmental regional organizations whose mandate specifically
40 concerns the region in conflict,

41 (b) UN organizations or subsidiary bodies currently engaged and actively
42 participating in the area of conflict,

43 (c) Regional and local non-governmental organizations currently engaged
44 and actively participating in the area of conflict,

45 (d) Private transnational organizations with sufficient capacity for
46 divestment
