The Historical Security Council

1	Guided by the United Nations Charter,
2 3 4	Affirming the deep cultural significance of the city of Jerusalem,
4 5 6	Acknowledging the current hostilities in the region,
7 8	Recognizing the necessity for a peaceful solution to the Palestinian Question,
9 10	1. <i>Creates</i> Jerusalem as a neutral city void of national military and political entities under the international jurisdiction of United Nations Security Council;
11 12	2. <i>Establishes</i> the United Nations Protectorate of Jerusalem (UNPJ) consisting of
13 14	sufficient UN security force to maintain the peace and secure access to the UNPJ;
14 15 16	3. <i>Appoints</i> a high commissioner to head the administrative body of the UNPJ;
17 18 19 20	4. <i>Creates</i> a municipal council consisting of residents from the city of Jerusalem appointed by the High Commissioner of the UNPJ with the authority to legislate on all quotidian administrative functions and necessary maintenance;
20 21 22 23	5. <i>Grants</i> all citizens of all nations visitation rights to the neutral UNPJ contingent on the receipt of appropriate visas granted by the authority of the UNPJ;
24 25 26	6. <i>Permits</i> all Israeli and Jordanian citizens uncontested access to, and permission to reside in, the UNPJ contingent on proving citizenship of their respective country;
27 28 29	7. <i>Fully acknowledges</i> the right of all current residents of the city of Jerusalem to maintain residency in the UNPJ;
30	8. Establishes a Weapons-For-Food Program under the auspice of the municipal

- 31 council of the UNPJ for the purpose of creating a weapons free city;
- 3233 9. *Permits* the High Commissioner of the UNPJ to carry out a territory-wide
- 34 sweep following the completion of the Weapons-For-Food Program for the purpose of
- 35 guaranteeing compliance with the weapons-free, non-military mandate given under
- 36 operative clause one.
