The Historical Security Council

- 1 *Acknowledging* the current instability in the United Nations Protectorate of
2 Jerusalem (UNPJ), formerly the city of Jerusalem,
3
- 4 *Emphasizing* the tenuous peace created in accordance with the Jordanian-Israeli
5 General Armistice Agreement,
6
- 7 *Taking into consideration* that both Israel and Jordan desire to resolve this
8 situation and that they are willing to collaborate with each other and the UN for such
9 purpose,
10
- 11 *Recognizing* the past success and legitimacy of the United Nations Truce
12 Supervision Organization (UNTSO) in the region,
13
- 14 *Respecting* the moderate success and familiarity of the municipal council under
15 the High Commissioner of the UNPJ in legislating on behalf of the people of the UNPJ
16 prior to the outbreak of violence,

- 18 1. *Rescinds* HSC/1;
19
- 20 2. *Reconstitutes* the municipal council of clause 4 of HSC/1 as the Israel-
21 Jordanian Diplomatic Forum (IJDF) for airing and resolving disputes under the
22 facilitation of the UNTSO;

- 24 3. *Mandates* that the UNTSO facilitate discussions within the IJDF for the
25 purpose of maintaining a peaceful resolution to the situation in Jerusalem following the
26 rescension of HSC/1;

- 28 4. *Maintains* the original representation of the municipal council;

- 30 5. *Permits* the respective governments of Israel and Jordan the right to appoint

31 representatives to the IJDF;

33 6. *Declares* accordingly the immediate withdrawal of United Nations

34 peacekeeping troops;

35 7. *Orders* the UNTSO to provide monthly reports to the Security Council on the

36 status of the situation in Jerusalem and a cumulative year-end report on said situation.
