The Historical Security Council

1	Noting with regret the hostilities around the Suez Canal,
2	Recognizing the Israeli-Egyptian General Armistice Agreement,
3 4	<i>Understanding</i> that the Suez Canal Company was an Egyptian company under a majority of foreign control prior to the nationalization of the canal,
5 6	<i>Fully aware</i> of the negotiations discussed between Egypt, France, the United Kingdom, and the United States of America,
7	Desiring that such negotiations will lead to immediate ceasefire,
8 9 10	<i>Affirming</i> the current cease-fire negotiations between the United States, the United Kingdom, France, Israel and Egypt,
10 11 12 13 14 15	 Draws the attention to the negotiations that work towards (a) The United Kingdom and France will temporarily advance to and fortify positions on the West Bank of the Suez Canal, and thereby gaining full control of the Suez Canal and permitting Israeli ships to pass through unmolested,
16 17 18	(i)With acknowledgement that such an agreement will be maintained until negotiations within the United Nation True Supervision Organization (UNTSO) provide an alternative solution,
19 20	(ii) Demanding constant input from all parties to the UNTSO in promotion for future solutions,
21 22	2. Authorizes the United Kingdom and France to permit reallocation of the rights of investment to Egypt in specific issues relating to the Suez Canal,
23 24	3. Proclaims the creation of a dam on the Nile River, specifically located in the southern region of Egypt, funded by the United Kingdom and the United States,
25 26	4. Promotes the use of the UNTSO to facilitate the function of the shareholders in future negotiations surrounding the Suez Canal.
