



SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Middle East

*The Historical Security Council*

- 1 *Noting with regret* the hostilities around the Suez Canal,
- 2 *Recognizing* the Israeli-Egyptian General Armistice Agreement,
- 3 *Understanding* that the Suez Canal Company was an Egyptian company under a
- 4 majority of foreign control prior to the nationalization of the canal,
- 5 *Fully aware* of the negotiations discussed between Egypt, France, the United
- 6 Kingdom, and the United States of America,
- 7 *Desiring* that such negotiations will lead to immediate ceasefire,
- 8 *Affirming* the current cease-fire negotiations between the United States, the United
- 9 Kingdom, France, Israel and Egypt,
- 10
- 11 1. *Draws the attention* to the negotiations that work towards
- 12 (a) The United Kingdom and France will temporarily advance to and
- 13 fortify positions on the West Bank of the Suez Canal, and thereby
- 14 gaining full control of the Suez Canal and permitting Israeli ships to
- 15 pass through unmolested,
- 16 (i) With acknowledgement that such an agreement will be maintained
- 17 until negotiations within the United Nations Truce Supervision
- 18 Organization (UNTSO) provide an alternative solution,
- 19 (ii) Demanding constant input from all parties to the UNTSO in
- 20 promotion for future solutions,
- 21 2. Authorizes the United Kingdom and France to permit reallocation of the rights
- 22 of investment to Egypt in specific issues relating to the Suez Canal,
- 23 3. Proclaims the creation of a dam on the Nile River, specifically located in the
- 24 southern region of Egypt, funded by the United Kingdom and the United States,
- 25 4. Promotes the use of the UNTSO to facilitate the function of the shareholders in
- 26 future negotiations surrounding the Suez Canal.
