SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Pakistan

The Security Council

1 *Aware of* the developing internal situation in Pakistan and its potentially
2 destabilizing effects,
3

4 *Recognizing* the political, economic, and social implications created by such
5 instability,
6

7 *Fully respecting* the sovereignty and self-determination of Pakistan and its right
8 under the Charter of the United Nations to govern its own internal affairs,
9

10 *Further recognizing* Pakistan's strategic importance as a nuclear power and a key
11 figure in the international effort against terrorism in all its forms,
12

13 *Emphasizing* that, because the matter at hand is entirely resolvable through
14 internal actions of Pakistan itself with regional or international assistance, the United
15 Nations Security Council holds no hostile intentions against the government or people of
16 Pakistan,
17

18 *Recalling* previous situations in which a crisis seemed imminent in which the
19 United Nations or one of its constituent bodies has sent an envoy to ascertain the facts on
20 the ground before taking further action,
21

22 1. *Encourages* the Islamic Republic of Pakistan to accept all neutral fact-finding
23 efforts of the UN in the spirit of inquiry;
24

25 2. *Recommends* that the Secretary-General, as soon as feasibly possible and with
26 the full consent of Pakistan, dispatch an ambassadorial envoy representing the United
27 Nations Security Council to accomplish the following actions:

29 a. Examine the current state of affairs within Pakistan's territory, in full
30 cooperation with government of Pakistan;

32 b. Determine the veracity of claims made about humanitarian concerns;

c. Offer Pakistan assistance and resources towards the goal of swiftly facilitating the promotion of peace and security in the region;

d. Consider the options and resources available to the United Nations towards that same goal;

3. *Affirms* that no punitive measures in any form are under consideration by the United Nations Security Council;

4. *Decides* to remain actively seized on the issue.
