1 2 3	<i>Recalling</i> Article 7 of the United Nations charter regarding collective security in a time of crisis and Article 2, paragraph 4 which calls all member states to refrain from the use of force against the territorial integrity or political independence of any state,
4 5 6	Recalling also Resolution 487 adopted by consensus of the Council,
7 8	Cognizant of the gravity of the current situation,
9 10 11	<i>Recognizing</i> the escalation of the conflict and the involvement of third parties and non-state actors,
12 13 14	<i>Noting with concern</i> the losses sustained by Coalition forces at the hands of non- state actors in Iraq,
14 15 16 17	<i>Deeply regretting</i> the human losses sustained by all parties involved, especially due to attacks on civilians by non-state actors,
17 18 19 20	<i>Recognizing</i> the sovereign right of all member states to defend themselves against threats to their security,
20 21 22 23	<i>Alarmed by</i> the consequences of the preemptive strikes on Iranian facilities on the peace and stability of the Middle Eastern region,
23 24 25 26	<i>Deeply concerned</i> with the impact of subsequent economic and military retaliations on the international community,
20 27 28	1. Condemns the recent attacks on the Iranian facilities by Israel;
29 30	2. <i>Affirms</i> the aforementioned attacks as a violation of Article 2, paragraph 4 of the United Nations charter;
31 32	3. Calls upon Israel and the Islamic Republic of Iran to engage in diplomatic talks;

- 4. Calls for a deepened commitment to peace in the Middle East region;
- 38 5. *Resolves* to remain seized in the matter.
