2 3	Convinced of the role that public-private partnerships and Non-Governmental
	Organizations (NGOs) must play in rural development,

6	Recognizing the importance and effect that the United Nations Public-Private
7	Alliance (UNPPA) has had and the work that the program has done,

9	Having examined what was learned from the Secretary General's report on the
10 11	UNPPA on 27 July 2007,
11	Noting the current international economic situation and the necessity of continued
12	work towards worldwide development,

18	Bearing in mind that skill development and education are necessary tenets of
