The Economic and Social Council

1 *Recognizing* the desire of rural communities to achieve sustainable development,
2 as well as their willingness to accept the investment of public and private business
3 entities to do so,
4

5 *Believing* that technological innovations hold the potential to facilitate the
6 coordination and cooperation between rural communities and both international and local
7 businesses,
8

9 *Fully aware* that reports on development issued by the United Nations, associated
10 agencies and private organizations are available to the public,
11

12 1. *Recommends* that all reports on private-public alliances become accessible
13 through an electronic database for the purpose of attracting suitable investors to the
14 appropriate resources and communities within the pilot states;
15

16 2. *Further recommends* that a database be created that centralizes information
17 produced by international organizations regarding rural development for the purpose of
18 facilitating coordination between such organizations and the participating United Nations
19 Public-Private Alliance for Rural Development (UNPPA) pilot states, and that:

20 (a) UNPPA will be responsible for compiling the data base and its contents
21 which will be limited to pilot states, which currently includes Madagascar, Dominican
22 Republic, Angola, and Ethiopia until additional pilot states are added;

23 (b) Information assembled will be accessible to all interested parties.

Passed by consensus, with 5 abstentions
