SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Afghanistan

1 *Echoing the sentiments* of “cautious optimism” expressed at the Bucharest  
2 Summit in April 2008,  
3

4 *Convinced* that ensuring stability in the southern and eastern regions of  
5 Afghanistan is the surest method of reducing the violence that devastates the region,  
6

7 *Recognizing* that a multidimensional approach to resolving the situation in  
8 Afghanistan is necessary for a comprehensive approach to security,  
9

10 *Welcoming* further methods of United Nations involvement in securing the  
11 southern and eastern regions of Afghanistan,  
12

13 1. *Endorses* the creation of regional training districts in the south and expansion of  
14 those already operating in the east with the objective of specifically developing  
15 capabilities in:

- 16 (a) Countering Improvised Explosive Devices;  
17 (b) Strategic planning to preemptively target any parties directly opposing peace  
18 and stability within Afghanistan;  
19 (c) Training Police Mentor Teams and European Union Police to ensure  
20 sustainability and infrastructure in the region;  
21

22 2. *Reaffirms* the importance of effective Police Mentor Teams by extending the  
23 program for a period of three years, at which point the United Nations will reconsider the  
24 necessity of this presence.
