The First Committee

- 1 *Aware* of the grave danger poised by nuclear weapons to every and all nations,
2
3 *Recognizing* the need to limit the number of strategic land based nuclear missiles
4 in continental Europe for the sake of world peace and stability,
5
6 *Realizing* the significance of strategic nuclear weapons for the security of and
7 protection of the European continent,
8
9 *Believing* that land based nuclear weapons are rapidly becoming obsolete and
10 irrelevant as European controlled nuclear weapons are increasingly reliant on submarine
11 based missiles,
12
13 *Recalling* that the Non-Proliferation Treaty calls upon established nuclear powers
14 to work for nuclear disarmament,
15
16 *Seeking* to advance the common causes of European and Global security,
17
18 1. *Calls for* the establishment of a nuclear weapon free Europe that:
19 (a) Is limited to only land based nuclear weapons;
20 (b) Is limited to the boundaries of the European continent which would
21 include all European states with the exception of contiguous Russia;
22 (c) In no way inhibits the capacity of those European states legally allowed
23 by the Non-Proliferation Treaty to possess nuclear weapons to deploy sea and air
24 based nuclear deterrent;
25 (d) Dismantles and/or converts all infrastructure pertaining to land based
26 missiles to civilian use;
27 (e) Is established within 10 years.
