



SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Southern Rhodesia

The Historical Security Council

1 *Recognizing* the current measures being taken to address the situation in Southern
2 Rhodesia,

3
4 *Aknowledging* the complexity of the Southern Rodesian situation and the delays,

5
6 *Realizing* the nature of the minority government led by Ian Smith as a
7 misrepresentation of the Zimbabwean majority and a suppressor of the majority
8 population of Zimbabwe,

9
10 *Considering* the draining effects that economic sanctions had, not only for the
11 Smith regime, but for the majority population and therefore the threat to the population's
12 vitality that a continuation of this situation will cause,

13
14 *Also recognizing* the appeals of Southern Rhodesia's neighbors for assistance in
15 removing a regional threat,

16
17 *Deploring* the interest of some entities for inciting violence and hurting the
18 possibility of a peaceful resolution,

20 1. *Urges* a five month ultimatum period during which the United Kingdom will
21 work in conjunction with the Ian Smith regime in order to remove the minority led
22 government in favor of installing a majority led government;

23
24 2. *Suggests* incentives, such as political asylum, be offered to the members of the
25 Ian Smith regime in order to facilitate the
26 abdication of the current administration;

28 3. *Requests* a gathering of the Security Council after the five month period in
29 order to review the progress made between Southern Rhodesia and the United Kingdom;

30 (a) At this gathering, if progress is still needed within the region, the
31 Security Council will deliver a final warning to the Ian Smith regime that abdication is
32 imperative;

34 4. *Endorses* the pursuit of peaceful means of conflict resolution as the primary line
35 of action but also recognizes that military force may be necessary in order to solve this
36 conflict in an effective and efficient manner;

38 5. *Also urges* the increase of aid given to nations whose economies are directly
39 effected by the Southern Rhodesian economic sanctions,

41 6. *Requests* that during the aforementioned five month period the Trusteeship
42 Council will outline a framework for the transition of the Zimbabwean government into
43 majority hands, to be implemented following the reconvention of the Security Council
44 after the five month period; barring any event of an egregious enough nature to make this
45 no longer viable.
