4. *Endorses* the pursuit of peaceful means of conflict resolution as the primary line of action but also recognizes that military force may be necessary in order to solve this conflict in an effective and efficient manner;

Requests that during the aforementioned five month period the Trusteeship Council will outline a framework for the transition of the Zimbawean government into majority hands, to be implemented following the reconvention of the Security Council after the five month period; barring any event of an egregious enough nature to make this no longer viable.
