*The Historical Security Council*

1            *Noting* reports of continuing violence that require the continued presence of the  
2 United Peace-keeping Force in Cyprus, to prevent any escalation of the intensity of the  
3 violence,  
4

5            *Futher Noting* that the Government of Cyprus has agreed that in view of the  
6 prevailing conditions in the island, it is necessary to continue the United Peace-keeping  
7 Force beyond June 26, 1967,  
8

9            1. *Reaffirms* its resolutions 186 (1964) of 4 March, 187 (1964) of 13 March, 192  
10 (1964) of 20 June, 193 (1964) of 9 August, 194 (1964) of 25 September and 198 (1964)  
11 of 18 December 1964, 201 (1965) of 19 March, 206 (1965) of 15 June, 207 (1965) of 10  
12 August and 219 (1965) of 17 December 1965, 220 (1966) of 16 March and 222 (1966) of  
13 16 June, 231 (1966) of 15 December 1966, and the consensus expressed by the President  
14 at the 1143rd meeting, on 11 August 1964;

16            2. *Urges* the parties concerned to act with the utmost restraint and to continue  
17 determined co-operative efforts to achieve the objectives of the Security Council;  
18

19            3. *Extends*, once more, the stationing in Cyprus of the United Nations  
20 peacekeeping Force, established under Security Council resolution 186 (1964), for a  
21 further period of six months, ending 26 December 1967, in the aspiration that by then  
22 sufficient progress towards a solution will make possible a withdrawal or substantial  
23 reduction of the United Nations peacekeeping Force.
