



SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Israeli-Arab Situation

*The Historical Security Council*

1           *Recognizing* that past conversations and resolutions have been ineffective in  
2 providing lasting peace,

3  
4           *Convinced* that the current situation in the Middle East requires immediate action  
5 by the Security Council,

6  
7           *Understanding* that the maintenance of national sovereignty of all nations  
8 involved is of the utmost importance,

9  
10           1. *Calls* for an immediate ceasefire between all parties involved in the Israeli-Arab  
11 conflict;

12  
13           2. *Provides* UN-subscribed humanitarian aid packages to all civilian parties who  
14 need such aid within the dispute;

15  
16           3. *Stresses* the importance of normalized relations between Israel and the  
17 surrounding Arab nations;

19           4. *Calls* for peace talks between Israel and Arab states in order to establish a bond  
20 of trust to encourage peace and security in the Middle-East;

22           5. *Establishes* an Arbitration Committee to monitor the ongoing situation in the  
23 Middle East between Israeli and Arab forces;

24                   (a) This Committee will be comprised of nine members;

25                   (i) Three of these members belonging to NATO, nominated by the United  
26 States and accepted by the Security Council;

27                   (ii) Three of these members under the umbrella of the Warsaw Pact,  
28 nominated by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and accepted by the  
29 Security Council;

30                   (iii) Three of the members being non-aligned states, nominated and  
31 selected by the Security Council;

32                   (b) This Committee will have investigative powers and support from the

34 Security Council in order to bring forth knowledge of egregious acts of violence which  
35 cross borders;

36 (i) According to the acquired knowledge of the investigation, this  
37 Committee will have the authority to punish and condemn as they see fit,  
38 according to a simple majority after authorization for the punishment or  
39 condemnation has been granted by the Security Council;

40 (c) This Committee will monitor the ceasefire and report to the Security  
41 Council on actions that go against that conference;

42 (d) This Committee will make recommendations to the Security Council  
43 on the use of force and the mobilization of peace keeping force within the area;

44 (e) Allows this Committee to be approached by any party involved in the  
45 dispute;
