The Security Council

- 1 *Deeply concerned* by the violence in the Nord Kivu of the Democratic Republic of the
2 Congo,
3
4 *Noting with concern* the proximity of the violence to the refugee camp in Goma,
5
6 *Recognizing* the need of the 700,000 refugees in Goma for food and medical aid,
7
8 *Acknowledging* the generous contribution of food aid by the United States of Amer and
9 France,
10
11 1. *Recognizes* the need for a ceasefire agreement in order to reinstate humanitarian aid to
12 Goma;
13
14 2. *Encourages* the utilization of the airport in Goma proper to deliver food aid for the
15 700,000 refugees located within Goma and the surrounding area;

17 3. *Further encourages* the United Nations peacekeeping forces called for on 20
18 November 2008 in S/RES/1843 to help escort food and medical aid to Goma from Mugunga via
19 the east/west access road;
20
21 4. *Request* the United Nations peacekeeping forces called for on 20 November 2008 in
22 S/RES/1843 to contribute military aid to protect refugees and civilians within Goma and Kibati,
23 and secure and maintain the east/west access road from Mugunga to Goma;

25 5. *Invites* all nations able and willing to provide food and medical aid to help alleviate
26 the impending humanitarian crisis.
