SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Right of Peoples to Self-Determination

*The General Assembly*

1           *Recalling* that the right of people to self determination is enshrined in the United  
2 Nations Charter,

3  
4           *Recognizing* the right of the people of the Palestinian Authority to govern themselves  
5 through a state fully recognized by the international community and the United Nations,

6  
7           *Guided by* the commitment of the governments of Israel and Palestine to reach a two-  
8 state solution that ensures the safety and security of both states,

9  
10          *Affirming* the 2003 Road Map constructed by the quartet of the United States, Russian  
11 Federation, European Union, and United Nations as the most agreeable vehicle to bring about  
12 peace in the region and statehood for the Palestinian government,

13  
14          *Deeply concerned* that continued settlement building by Israelis in East Jerusalem and  
15 the West Bank, in addition to the continued implementation of the barrier wall by the  
16 government of Israel, are in violation of pertinent international legal norms and are major  
17 roadblocks to the peace process,

18  
19          1. *Urges* the Security Council to consider member status in the United Nations for  
20 Palestine in no less than two years if Israel does not commit to the below subclauses in six  
21 months:

22           (a) *Urges* Israel to immediately cease construction of the barrier wall and all settlements  
23 in East Jerusalem and the West Bank, including natural growth of settlements;

24           (b) *Further urges* Israel and Palestine to recommit to substantive peace talks in  
25 accordance with the 2003 Road Map;

26           (c) *Additionally urges* the government of Israel to recognize the borders of the future  
27 state of Palestine as the pre-1967 borders as articulated by Security Council Resolution 242 and  
28 the 1949 Armistice "Green" line.
