15	Emphasizing how essential is to promote and empower women in rural areas as an
16	effective way to combat the cycle of poverty, hunger and disease, and to stimulate a truly
17	sustainable development,

19	Endorsing the action taken by The International Fund for Agricultural Development
20	(IFAD) by promoting access to agricultural credit loans, enforcement of agricultural technology,

30	on supporting agricultural development, most importantly to women who are small holders,
31	helping them to produce and sell their staple commodities and, as a result, raise their income,

33	<i>Fully aware</i> of the importance of tackling desertification, most importantly in desert
34	areas such as Sub-Saharan considering that deserts are eroding and this diminishes viable soil

37 38	1. <i>Recommends</i> the extension of a program of microcredits as incentives for business women in rural areas with the consultancy of The Grameen Foundation, the G-77 and the Perez
39	Guerrero Trust Fund that includes:
40 41	(a) Creation of a sustainable platform for rural women in order to share their experiences among communities, discuss new ideas and identify business;
42	(b) Provide economical guidance to maximize benefits at lower costs and help them
43	develop business plans;
44	(c) Commission a study on the results of this program with the purpose of finding out
45	positive or negative trends;
46	(d) Selection of feasible business opportunities;
47	(d) beleenon of reasible business opportunities,
48	2. Endorses the Health Action Plan sponsored by the World Health Organization with
49	the following main goals:
50	(a) Services of mobile ambulatories that can have access to provide medical assistance
51	and family planning to small communities and rural areas, with specialized training and
52	knowledge concerning women;
53	(b) Promote a system with an established schedule of the dates and time the ambulatory
54	mobiles are going to be in specific areas;
55	(c) Create a vaccination and vitamin card system so that women have the proper control
56	and treatment programs during and after pregnancy;
57	(d) Train groups of women in rural areas to be midwives so they can assist during labor
58	with the basic medical procedures;

60	3. Further Recommends Member States to fully expand of the Purchase for Progress
61 62	Program (P4P) in areas where agriculture is a fundamental source of income with the purpose of promote effective solutions that are culturally accepted as well as environmentally conscious and
63	economically sustainable;

65	4. Strongly encourages governments to empower women and implement the action taken
66	by the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) by promoting access to
67	agricultural credit loans and enforcement of agricultural technology;
68	
69	5. Further encourages Member States to provide expertise on technological, managerial,
70	and medical subject matters concerning rural women in small communities based on passed
71	experiences to lesser developed countries;

73	6. Requests governments to implement environmentally conscious methods and the
74	actions of the United Nations Convention to Counter Desertification (UNCCD) that provide aid
75	to rural women in domestic affairs in order to maximize productive time and security.
