The Historical Security Council

- 1 *Reaffirming* its resolutions 143 (1960), 145 (1960), 146 (1960), and 1 (1961),
2
3 *Noting with sorrow* the continuation and escalation of attacks against civilians and
4 ONUC personnel in Katanga,
5
6 *Aware* that further deterioration of the security situation would likely result in an
7 exponential increase in the number of displaced persons,
8
9 *Guided by* the call for the cessation of violence as well the end to arms exports to the
10 Congo as called for by resolution 1 (1961),
11
12 *Deeply disturbed by* the diminishing number of ONUC personnel in the Congo,
13
14 *Realizing* that the only course of action for remedying these problems is to expand the
15 mandate of United Nations peacekeeping personnel in the Congo,
16
17 1. *Expands* the mandate of ONUC to allow United Nations personnel to take proactive
18 action to protect civilians in the Congo;

20 2. *Encourages* the Secretariat to prepare for the possibility of a humanitarian crisis
21 resulting from the displacement of persons;

23 3. *Authorizes* the establishment of transit checkpoints under the authority of ONUC to
24 enforce the small arms embargo established by resolution 1 (1961);

26 4. *Encourages* member nations, specifically non-aligned and African nations, to increase
27 their peace keeping contingents in the Congo;

29 5. *Further calls upon* United Nations member nations to increase funding for the United
30 Nations operation in the Congo.
