SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in the Congo SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council SUBMITTED BY: United Kingdom The Historical Security Council Reaffirming its resolutions 143 (1960), 145 (1960), 146 (1960), and 1 (1961), Noting with sorrow the continuation and escalation of attacks against civilians and ONUC personnel in Katanga, Aware that further deterioration of the security situation would likely result in an exponential increase in the number of displaced persons. Guided by the call for the cessation of violence as well the end to arms exports to the Congo as called for by resolution 1 (1961), Deeply disturbed by the diminishing number of ONUC personnel in the Congo, Realizing that the only course of action for remedying these problems is to expand the mandate of United Nations peacekeeping personnel in the Congo, 1. Expands the mandate of ONUC to allow United Nations personnel to take proactive action to protect civilians in the Congo; 2. Encourages the Secretariat to prepare for the possibility of a humanitarian crisis resulting from the displacement of persons; 3. Authorizes the establishment of transit checkpoints under the authority of ONUC to enforce the small arms embargo established by resolution 1 (1961);
